End of the Day

We seem to have an increasing number of issues at the end of the school day once again. The safety of the children is our paramount concern at the end of the day and all of our policies and procedures keep this in mind. From now on if someone different is collecting your child from school and you have not notified us, either at the start of the day by speaking to the class teacher or before 2.45pm by calling the school office, we will not release your child until we have spoken to a parent/carer. We do ask that all changes are communicated to us by 2.45pm to ensure we have time to notify the relevant people. We would also like to remind parents/carers that our school day finishes at 3.30pm and all children need to be collected at this time. We have an increasing number being collected late and this is simply not fair on our staff. Please ensure all children are collected promptly at the end of the day otherwise we will have to begin charging for wraparound care.
