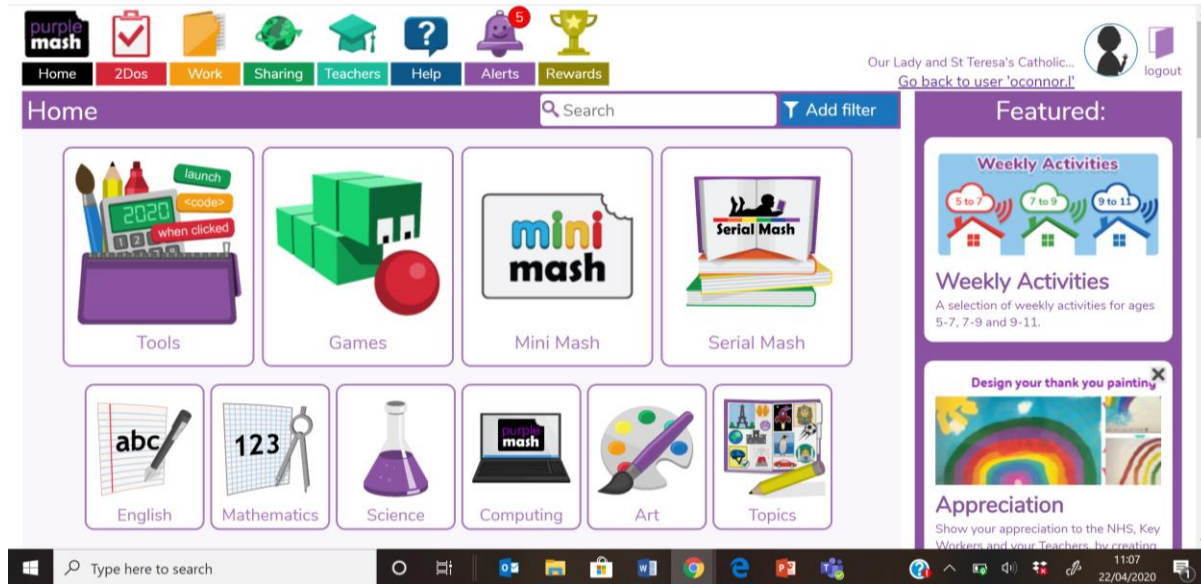


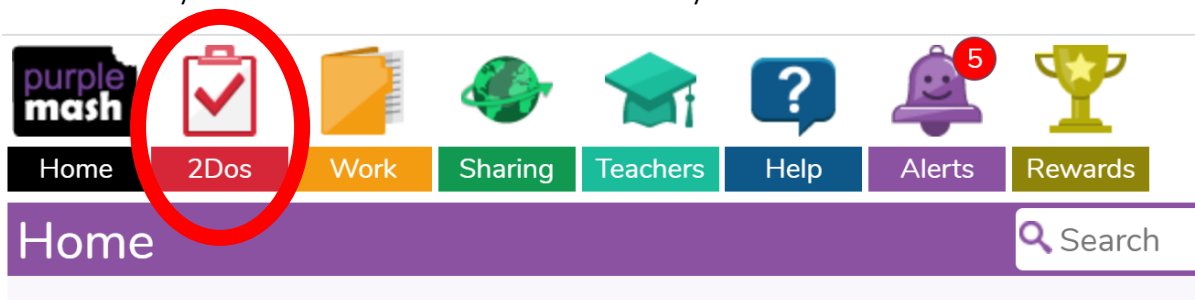
# Hello Everyone!

Here is my step-by-step guide to completing the work uploaded onto Purple Mash, I hope this helps!

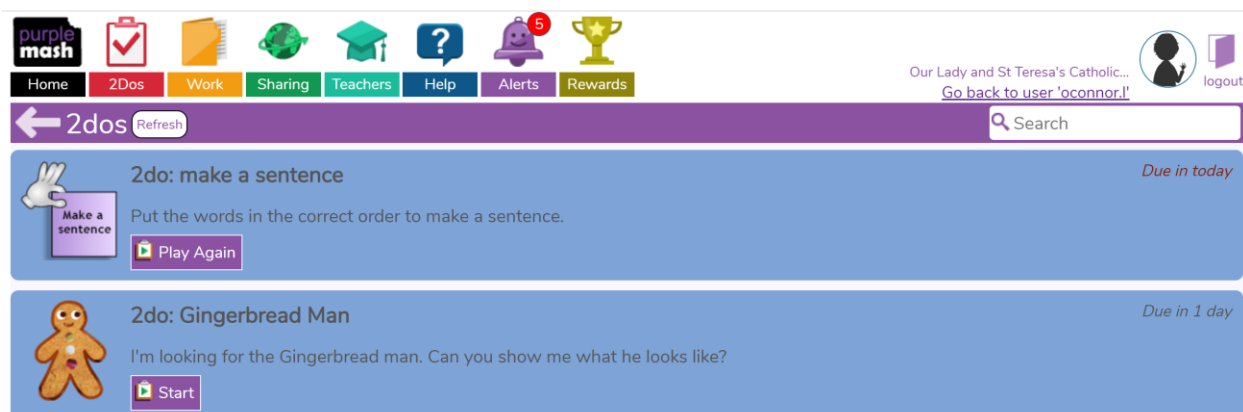
1. When you have logged onto purple mash using the login in the front of your scrapbooks you should see a page that looks like this.



2. Next you need to find the folder that says '2Dos'



3. When you click on the 2Dos folder it will give you a list of tasks that are coloured blue. It looks like this...



- Click on the activity and complete it! But don't forget to select **'hand it in'** at the end of the task. When you choose to hand in your work the task then changes to the colour **green** to highlight what you have already completed for next time.
