



A Guide to SpellingShed

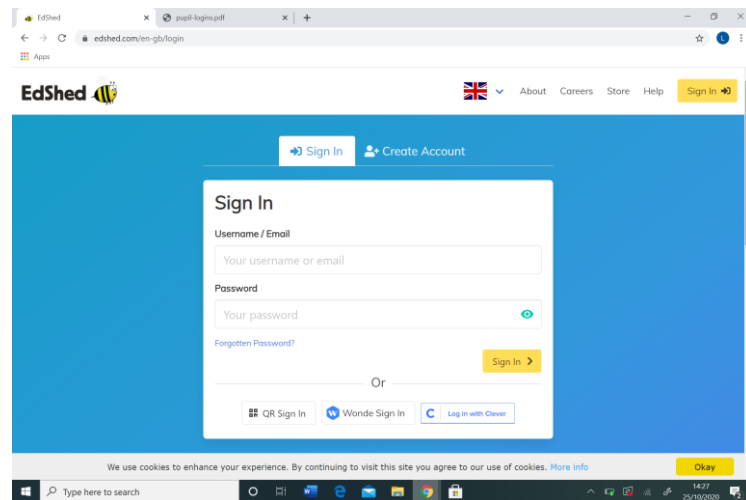


Hi all, I have created a quick guide to using SpellingShed - I hope this helps! Miss O 😊

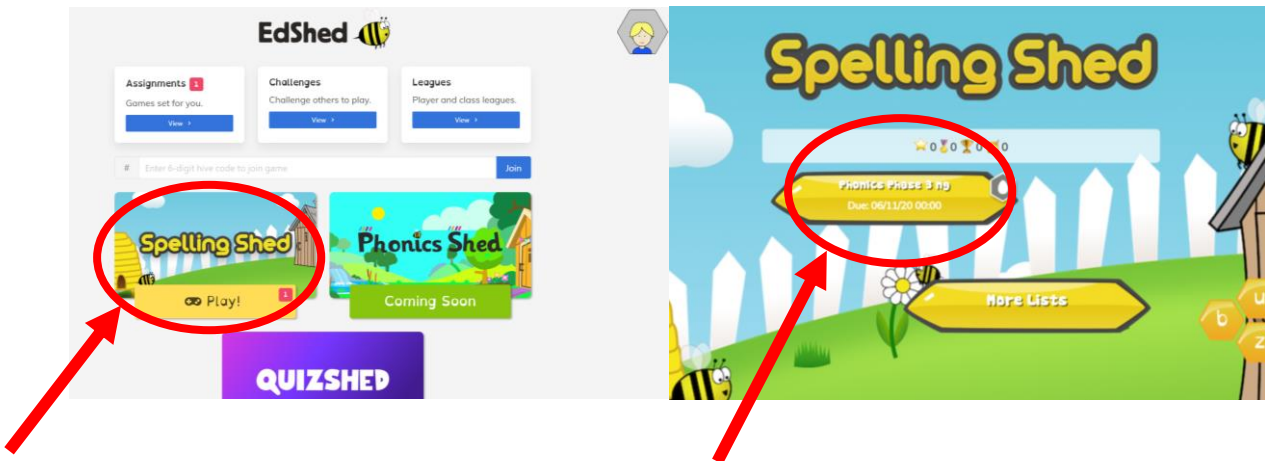
SpellingShed is an online platform to help the children learn and become more confident with spelling words. Please be aware that the children will be learning words associated to a spelling rule or phase in phonics. When the children are tested on their spellings there may be some extra words that haven't been practiced but the rule can be applied to.

There is no maximum number of times that the children should log in and participate on SpellingShed. However, the more they participate the better they will be at writing and the more their confidence in themselves will blossom. There will be a spelling test on a Friday.

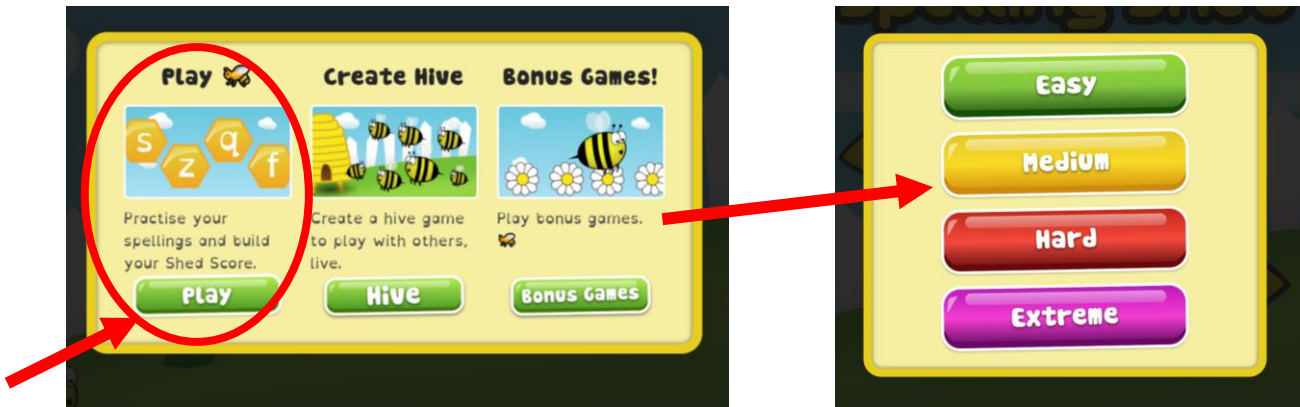
1. Go to the SpellingShed webpage <https://www.edshed.com/en-gb/login> or you can download the app on your device. Input your username and password to log in.



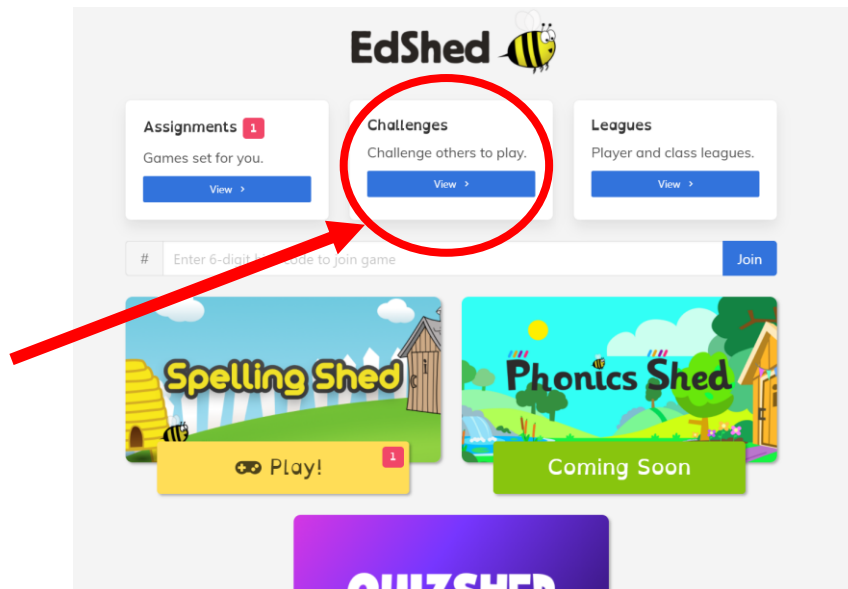
2. You will then arrive at this page. Click on 'Play!' and then the first button – this will be the spelling list that has been set for your child to complete.



3. When your child clicks this button they can then choose a level of difficulty before beginning their game. Once clicking the level the game will begin. Every time the children complete a game they can win points and awards. From this a leader board is generated.



4. Sometimes there will be extra challenges set on SpellingShed. You can access these by clicking on 'view' underneath 'challenges' when you first log in.



5. You will then arrive at this screen. You can click on play to have a go at the challenge and earn extra points.
