English, Phonics and Handwriting	Maths	RE
<p>Text: Superworm We will practice retelling the story of Superworm using some actions to help us. We will be looking at the characters and how we can describe them. Our main focus is to apply our phonics to our writing and ensure we are marking sentences with a capital letter and full stops.</p> <p>Phonics will continue using the scheme Read Write Inc</p> <p>Handwriting focus: o, c, a, e and d</p>	<p>This term our focus will be on Number recognition. We will be practice recognising different numbers in a variety of different representations. (A number of items, counters, cubes, numicon, numerals, word form etc.)</p> <p>We will also focus upon Counting forwards and backwards from 0-20 and beyond. We will do this both verbally and by finding the missing numbers in sequences.</p> <p>As always there will be a big push on the children showing the correct number formation within their work.</p>	<p>Creation</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - We will be sequencing the creation story and identifying what God created on each day. - We will also explore how we can help to look after the world God has created <p>Families and Celebrations</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - What does it mean to celebrate? - Why are families so important? - We will then explore how as Catholics we are all one big family in God - We will explore the key celebrations within the church's year and discuss how Mass is a celebration

PE	Science	Topic
<p>Our PE day is on Thursdays.</p> <p>Ball skills and team games. The skills in which we will be learning and practicing are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Being successful at catching - Throwing a ball in a variety of ways (chest, bounce, overhead etc.) - Being a part of a team - Basic attacking and defending skills 	<p>Animals including humans</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - We will be able to name some common animals and be able to match them to their offspring - We will be looking at the different animal classifications (mammals, birds, reptiles, amphibians and fish) - We will identify whether an animal is a herbivore, omnivore or carnivore - We will identify the different parts of our body and explore the importance of our 5 senses <p>Seasons We will begin to investigate the season of Autumn. We will go on a nature walk around the school field to observe the environment using our senses. We will be looking for the characteristics of Autumn.</p>	<p>Superheroes</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - We will begin by exploring what a superhero is and discuss who we believe to be superheroes in our own lives <p>This topic has a focus upon History - We will be researching the impact Florence Nightingale's career had on the world. We will do this by exploring; who she was, her role in the care of wounded soldiers and the changes she encouraged for the benefit of our health system.</p> <p>From this we will look at our own emergency services and their crucial role within society.</p>
