

## Autumn 2 : Great and Ghastly Events

English, Phonics and Handwriting	Maths	RE
<p><b>Text:</b> The Tiger Who Came to Tea We will practice retelling the story using some actions to help us. We will rewrite our own version of the story. Our main focus is to apply our phonics to our writing and ensure we are marking sentences with a capital letter and full stops.</p> <p><b>Phonics</b> we will continue using the scheme Read Write Inc</p> <p><b>Handwriting</b> focus: o, c, a, e and d</p>	<p>This term our focus will be on <b>comparing numbers and basic addition</b>.</p> <p>To begin with we will be comparing numbers; stating if one number is more than, less than or equal to another number.</p> <p>We will be focusing upon addition within 20. As our confidence grows, we will then attempt adding numbers with answers beyond 20.</p> <p>As always there will be a big push on the children showing the correct number formation within their work.</p>	<p><b>Prayer</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- We will explore how we can pray in a variety of different ways</li> <li>- Understand that prayer is a form of communicating with God</li> </ul> <p><b>Advent</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- We will be exploring how the season of Advent is a time for waiting and preparing for the birth of Jesus</li> <li>- Then we will be identify ways that we can prepare ourselves for the coming of Jesus</li> </ul>

PE	Science	Topic
<p>Our PE day is on <b>Thursdays</b>.</p> <p><b>Gymnastics</b> During our sessions we will be focusing upon strengthening our balancing skills and composing short sequences.</p> <p>We will be practicing different ways in which we can roll and attempt simple gymnastic moves such as bridges.</p>	<p><b>Materials</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Identify plastic, wood, metal and glass</li> <li>- Describe different materials</li> <li>- Compare and group materials based upon what they look like and their uses</li> </ul> <p><b>Seasons</b> We will begin to investigate the season of Autumn. We will go on a nature walk around the school field to observe the environment using our senses. We will be looking for the characteristics of Autumn.</p>	<p><b>Great and Ghastly Events</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- In this topic we will begin by recalling significant events within our lifetimes</li> </ul> <p>This topic has a focus upon <b>History</b> - We will be exploring the events of the Gunpowder Plot. Researching the involvement of Guy Fawkes and our local links to the plot.</p> <p>We will discover the reason why we celebrate bonfire night and research the different ways in which it is celebrated.</p>
