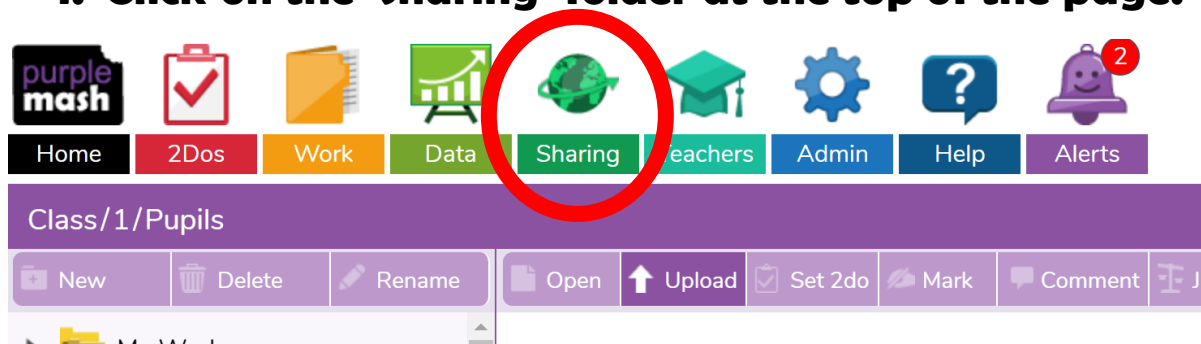


# Hello Everyone!

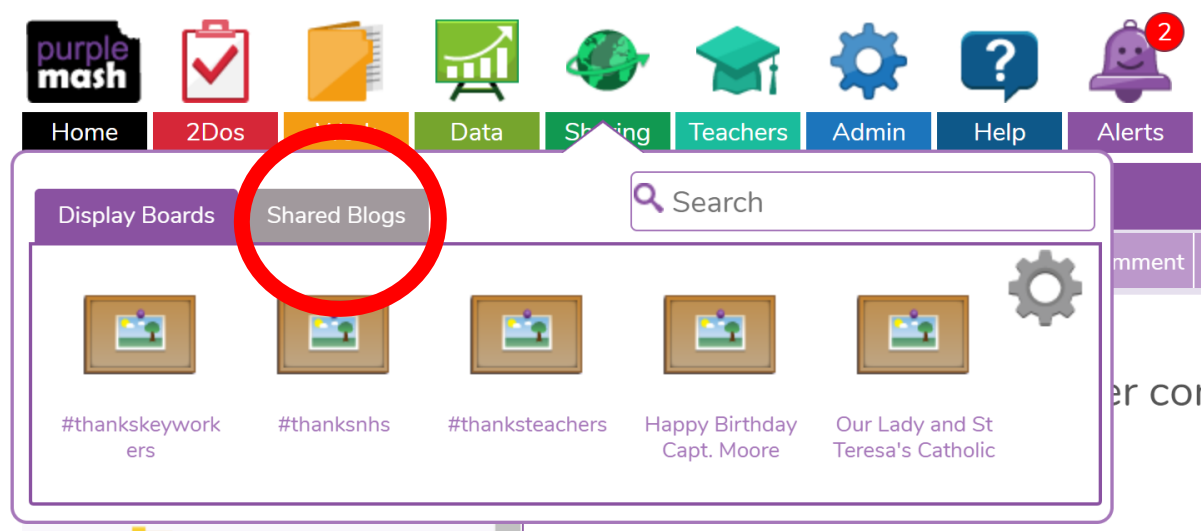
