Maths Challenge

Year 1 & 2 – the sum of two numbers is 22 and the difference between the two numbers is 14. What are the number?

Year 3 & 4 – Mr Smith's birth date value (the sum of the day and month of his birth e.g. 1st February, 1 + 2 = 3) is 19. What is his birthday? Is there only one possibility?

Year 5 & 6 - Mr Smith's birth date value (the product of the day and month of his birth e.g. 1st February, 1x2=2) is 112. What is his birthday?

Challenge – A football pitch has an area of 5390M², a rugby pitch measures 96m length and 56m wide. What's the difference in area? What could the length and width of the football pitch be?
