Maths Challenge

Year 1 & 2 — the sum of two numbers is 22 and the difference between the two numbers is 14. What are the number? **A:** 18 & 4

Year 3 & 4 – Mr Smith's birth date value (the sum of the day and month of his birth e.g. 1^{st} February, 1 + 2 = 3) is 19. What is his birthday? Is there only one possibility? **A:** 10^{th} September or 9^{th} October

Year 5 & 6 - Mr Smith's birth date value (the product of the day and month of his birth e.g. 1st February, 1x2=2) is 112. What is his birthday? **A:** 14th August

Challenge — A football pitch has an area of $5390M^2$, a rugby pitch measures 96m length and 56m wide. What's the difference in area? What could the length and width of the football pitch be? **A:** 14 M^2 70M X 77M
