Maths Challenge Answers for last week

YR – A: 4 & 6
Y1 & 2 – A: 16
Y3 & 4 – A: 51p

Challenge – A: 268 hours

Maths Challenge

Year R – Quiet Koala adds two numbers together, the sum is 9. One number is 3 bigger than the other. What are the numbers?

Year 1 & 2 – Mr & Mrs Smith share £24. Mr Smith has £4 more than Mrs Smith. How much do they have?

Year 3 & 4 – $\frac{1}{2}$ the length of a piece of wood is the same as $\frac{1}{4}$ the length of metal. The metal is 30cm longer. What are the lengths?

Year 5 & 6 – Four children add their ages together and get 31. Child A is twice the age of child B, child C is 3 times the age of child B and child D is 4 years older than child C. What are their ages?

Challenge – The product of two 2-digit numbers is 784. What are the numbers?
