Maths Challenge

- Year R** – Quiet Koala and Calvin the Cow add their cubes together. They have 7 between them. Calvin has one more than Quiet Koala. How many do they have each?
- Year 1 & 2** – $\frac{1}{4}$ of the fruit in a bowl are apples. There are 3 apples. How many pieces of fruit are in the bowl?
- Year 3 & 4** – Mr Smith bought a drink and snack for £5.00. The snack cost 80p more. How much did they cost?
- Year 5 & 6** –  What are the fractions of each piece of this tangram square? Explain your answer.

Challenge – $6x + 7 = 2x + 23$. What is the value of x?
