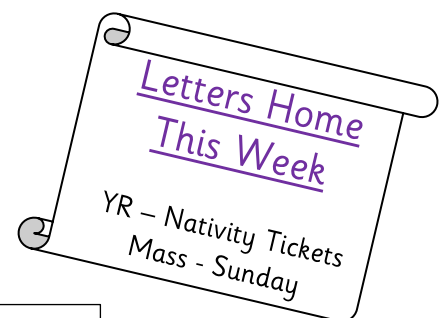

Maths Challenge

Year 1 & 2 – What is the missing number? $24+37= 68-?$
