YR – A: 4 each  
 Y1 & 2 – A: 38p, £3.80

## Maths Challenge

Year R – Quiet Koala shares sweets equally between his two friends and himself. He gets 3, how many did he have to start with?

Year 1 & 2 – In a fruit bowl  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the fruit are apples. There are 9 pieces of fruit which are not apples. How many pieces in the bowl?

Year 3 & 4 –  $\frac{3}{4}$  of a strip of paper is the same as  $\frac{3}{5}$  of another strip of paper. Which strip is longer?

Year 5 & 6 – Mr Smith buys a .75l bottle of medicine. You need to have 2.5ml 3 times per day. How long will the bottle last?

Challenge – 3 lots of a number plus 15 is the same as 5 lots of the same number plus 3. What is the number?
