Maths Challenge

Year R- Quiet Koala counts his cubes. Calvin the cow also counts his cubes. Calvin has double the amount as Quiet Koala. They have 6 altogether. How much does Calvin have? A: 4

Year 1 and 2- Mr Kalnins is thinking of a number. He adds half his number to the number he is thinking of and gets 18. What was his number? A: 12

Year 3 and 4 - 2/5 of an ice cream is vanilla. 180g is chocolate. How heavy is the ice cream? A: 300g

Year 5 and 6 - In a class, 80% of the children like sport. Of this 80%, ¾ like team sports. How many of the class like team sports as a percentage? A: 60%

Challenge: In a school, 55% of the pupils are girls. Out of the girls, the ratio of ones with blonde hair to ones with brown hair is 2:3. What percentages of pupils are blonde girls?

A: 22%
