Lesson 3

The Church celebrates the presence of the Holy Spirit in the Sacraments. Have a go at the matching activity and answer the **Bonus Questions**.

The Sacraments

Match the Sacraments to when the Oil of Chrism is used:

Baptism

The bishop anoints the forehead of the candidate with chrism saying, "Be sealed with the gift of the Holy Spirit."

Confirmation

The bishop anoints with chrism the palms of the new priest.

Holy Orders

The person is anointed on the crown of the head, "God the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ has freed you from sin and given you a new birth by water and the Holy Spirit."

The Oil of Chrism

Think about the qualities of oil;

- It can beautify and heal.
- It makes things work.
- It makes food pleasant.
- It strengthens and protects.

When people are anointed with the Oil of Chrism, at Baptism, Confirmation and Holy Orders, they are being given the gift of the Holy Spirit.
